History:

Bobo presents for an exam with Dr Davies because he has a gingival mass that appears to wax and wane in size. The mass was first seen on an exam at Forever Pet Dental in 2017.

Bobo has a history of MCT as well. The ulcerated mass on Bobo's tail has reduced to flat, as have multiple other lesions previously noted. The Gs apply a homemade salve and they say it reduces tumors.

Bobo will cough once or twice after he drinks water however, his Gs state this is his norm, there are no additional concerns at this time. Energy/appt good, no v/d/s, not PU/PD. -NJM
